Security Detail Instructions

Thank you for volunteering to as security for this meet. It is very important that you read, understand, and follow these instructions. Our primary goal is an enjoyable meet experience for all our guests and swimmers. In general:

- 1. Be polite and respectful;
- 2. Follow these instructions;
- 3. Do NOT let yourself be bullied anyone;
- 4. Contact the Mike Clark, Meet Director with any questions or concerns.

Security is expected at the following locations:

- 1. One person on the pool deck
- 2. Two people in the spectator gallery
- 3. One person at the bottom of stairs leading to the gallery from the Eagle Lobby

Rules and Regulations to Enforce:

- 1. For the person on the pool deck: No one is allowed on the pool deck without a BLUE wristband. If someone does not have wristband or has a different color wristband, escort them off the pool deck. Do not let them blow you off regardless of who they are.
 - NOTE: If someone is handicapped and cannot handle the stairs, send them to the pool deck and have them ask for the meet director. He will seat them appropriately.
- 2. No one is allowed in the spectator gallery without a BLUE or RED wristband. If someone does not have wristband, they may not enter the gallery until the pay admission. If admission is shut down, they can pay at concession.
- 3. If anyone has a wristband but is not wearing it, they must put it on immediately. Do not let someone show it to you and put it in there pocket.
- 4. The following are NOT permitted in the gallery:
 - a. Food
 - b. Portable seating either chairs or blankets
 - i. Not in the stairwells
 - ii. Not on the landings
 - iii. Not behind the top railing
 - c. No saving of seats with coats, newspapers, programs, blankets, etc.
- 5. No one is allowed to enter through the back stair case. One of security members in the spectator gallery should be at or near this door at all times.
- 6. No flash photography at the start of a race.
- 7. If anyone gets out of hand, ask them to calm down. If they refuse to calm down, ask them to leave. If they refuse to leave after two or three polite requests, contact the meet director or the CV Security Detail to have them escorted from the gallery.
