FACILITY:

CV High School Natatorium (Saturday/Sunday events)

The Saturday and Sunday sessions of this meet will be run in an eight lane competitive pool with adjustable bulkhead, and fully automatic timing. Adjustable bulkhead allows for 25 yard course with a five lane 25 yard warm down area. The starting end has a depth of 13 feet. The facility is equipped with Adolph Keiffer Wave Eater lane lines, Colorado Timing System, Aqua Grip electronic pads, and a ten-line readout scoreboard. Seating for up to 500 swimmers on deck and spectator balcony seating for up to 375. The balcony seating is LIMITED to 375 and this is a "controlled seating". By order of fire marshal and CV school district, we can NOT allow more than 375 spectators in the spectator gallery at any time. Free parking next to the building. Pool Certification — The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) of the USA Swimming Rules & Regulations, Section 202.3.5 A or B (page 57 in the 2013 Rules & Regs). The water depth at the turn end of the pool is 6 feet.

Fredricksen Natatorium (Friday events)

Housed within the Sollenberger Center includes an 8-lane, (6' depth at the start end and 5' depth at the turn end), 25-yard indoor swimming pool, along with a separate diving well for warm-up/warm-down. Temporary bleacher seating for 300; large deck area for swimmers, coaches and officials. Colorado 6000 timing system with LED matrix scoreboard. Hy-Tek Meet Manager 5.0 software. There will be no concession area at this facility. **Pool Certification** – The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) of the USA Swimming Rules & Regulations, Section 202.3.5 A or B (page 57 in the 2013 Rules & Regs).

ELIGIBILITY:	This meet is open to any swimmer registered in 2013 with USA Swimming. This meet will be run according to current USA Swimming rules and regulations. Swimmer's age on the first day of the meet determines age group for the entire competition.
ENTRY LIMITS:	Meet Director may add sessions, shift an event, limit the number of entries, eliminate certain events and/or heats, and any other reasonable modification to the meet format in order to complete sessions within the four (4) hour session limit. Notice will be provided promptly to swimmers and teams concerning modifications to the meet or changes to any entries/events/heats. Entry fees will be refunded to teams/swimmers whose entries have been rejected or who are unable to compete due to limitations. Swimmers are permitted to enter four (4) events per day (Saturday/Sunday) and one (1) event Friday night
WARM-UP:	USA Swimming and Middle Atlantic safety procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures: The warm-ups sessions may be divided into periods of equal length depending on the number of swimmers entered into each session. Warm-up schedules will be posted on the web site prior to the meet and will be made available to coaches at the meet.
	Sprint/Start lanes will be available at the end of each warm-up session. No diving or backstroke starts will be permitted except in sprint lanes, when designated.
	The referee may remove anyone from the warm-up for failure to comply with the warm-up rules.
	Swimmers without a coach must report to the Meet Director before entering the pool for warm-up in order to obtain a lane assignment. Swimmers without a coach who are 12&Under will swim with and be supervised by the host club during warm-up.
	Note: Swimmers violating safety procedures will be removed from the warm-up for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be disqualified from the remainder of the meet. Any swimmer observed swimming under or through the Bulkhead by an Official or Safety Monitor at the Meet will be disqualified from that swimmer's next Individual Event or from the remainder of the Meet, as determined by the Meet Referee. This policy will be strictly enforced.
SWIMWEAR:	Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition.

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DECK ENTRIES:

Subject to space availability, and at the discretion of the Meet Director, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet at the cost of \$8 per event. Swimmers not previously entered in the meet must provide proof of current USA Swimming registration. Deck entries will be accepted only until 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. Deck-entered swimmers will compete unofficially; the achieved time is official, but will not receive awards. To enter, please see the Meet Director before or during warm-ups. Deck entries must be paid for at the time of entry with cash or check. Swimmers will not be eligible for awards in deck-entered events.

HOW TO ENTER AND SEEDING:

This meet will be entirely Deck seeded. All teams and Unattached swimmers will be provided a check-in sheet for each session of the meet. Check-in sheets must be turned in to the scratch table 45 minutes before the start of the session. The meet will then be seeded and heat sheets will be provided to each team. The 500 frees, as well as 1000 free will be swum Fastest to Slowest alternating Women and Men.

Entries must be submitted in the course in which they were achieved. Converted times should NOT be used. All times submitted must be the swimmer's best time. Non Conforming times will be seeded last.

Swimmers without a valid USA Swimming time in an event must be submitted as a "NT" in that event.

Entries should be submitted using **HY-TEK or Team Unify** software format. The entry file may be found on the Middle Atlantic Swimming web site http://www.maswim.org

A hard copy printout listing each swimmer alphabetically, with each swimmer's events and entry times, must accompany the entry. If you are emailing your entry, please send a word file from your software sorted by athlete and event. This file will be used as your official entry. All emailed entries will receive confirmation of receiving your entry.

If a HY-TEK, Team Unify or any other software vendor file is not possible use the attached entry form.

Notice: As per Middle Atlantic regulations, failure to enter a swimmer's best time could result in suspension from competition for a minimum of 3 months, but not more than one year. Further violation by a coach, parent, or swimmer could result in that person being forbidden to participate in or attend USA Swimming functions.

CHECK IN

Each Team will receive a check-in sheet with all events listed for each session. All check-in sheets must be turned into the computer operator 45 minutes after the start of warm up. Swimmers that are being scratched should have their names circled with "SCR" next to the circle. Swimmers scratching a single event will have a line through the event number with "SCR" next to the line. Please use a simple line,

	not a scribble, so that the name can still be read. There is no penalty for swimmers that are not scratched and then do not swim their event.

ENTRY DEADLINE:	ALL ENTRIES must be received by Friday, September 20, 2013 at 7pm. No late entries will be accepted				
START PROCEDURE:	This Meet will be conducted using the No Recall false start rule. This Meet will also use the whistle command starting procedure. 'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.				
AWARDS:	Awards are presented for each event based on the entry time, not on the time swum during the meet. For example, a swimmer entered into an event with an "A" time or above is eligible to receive a "A" award. A swimmer entered into the meet with a "BB" time is eligible to receive a "BB" award. Swimmers entered into the meet with a time below a "BB" or as "no time" will be eligible to receive a "C" award. Deck entered swims are not be eligible for awards. In the 12 & Under 500 Free and 400 IM, the 9-10 & 11-12 age groups will be swum together but will be awarded separately. In the Senior 1000 Free and 400 IM, all swimmers will swim together, but 13-14 age group will be awarded separately. "A" Awards: Medals 1st to 3rd Ribbons 4th to 8th "C" Awards: Double Ribbons 1st to 3rd Ribbons 4th to 8th There will be no awards for Senior/Open.				
ADMISSION:	Admission is \$5 per person per session on Saturday and Sunday. There is NO				
	ADMISSION charge on Friday evening. (children under 12 are free). Heat Sheets are free and will be distributed AFTER coaches return scratch sheets				

SAFETY:	Current USA Swimming Safety Rules will be in effect and will be strictly enforced.
DECK ACCESS:	By USA Swimming ruling, deck access is limited to swimmers, coaches, officials & meet workers. Officials and coaches must wear their USA Swimming ID cards to be allowed on deck.
HOSPITALITY:	There will be food and drinks available in the Eagle Lobby on Saturday and Sunday for officials and coaches. Bottled water will be available on the pool deck for the Friday night session at Messiah College
TIMERS:	Volunteer Timers may be needed for this meet. Volunteers will receive a refund on their admission and a meal ticket for the concession area.
SPECTATORS:	Balcony seating at Cumberland Valley is available for up to 375 spectators. The balcony seating is LIMITED to 375 and this is a "controlled seating". By order of fire marshal and CV school district, we can NOT allow more than 375 spectators in the spectator gallery at any time. We also have a large concession area in the lobby with plenty of seating

MANUALLY SUBMITTED ENTRIES	As per Middle Atlantic rules, a \$15 per swimmer fee will be charged to all entries submitted on paper rather than electronically. An additional \$25 per swimmer fee will be charged to any team submitted entries for more than 5 swimmers manually. We have information on the final page of this meet entry about a HY-Tek product that is FREE (TM-Lite). This product will assist you in completing your electronic entry.
SWIMMERS WITHOUT A COACH	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
DECK REGISTRATION	Unregistered swimmers may register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Director. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$120 per swimmer for 2013-2014 registration). This applies to all swimmers attached to a club.
SWIMMERS WITH A DISIBILITY	Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted
DECK CHANGING	Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
RECORDING BAN	The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
