FACILITY:	CV High School Natatorium <i>(Saturday/Sunday events)</i> The Saturday and Sunday sessions of this meet will be run in an eight lane competitive pool with adjustable bulkhead, and fully automatic timing Adjustable bulkhead allows for 25 yard course with a five lane 25 yard warm down area The starting end has a depth of 13 feet. The facility is equipped with Adolph Keiffer Wave Eater lane lines, Colorado Timing System, Aqua Grip electronic pads, and a ten-line readout scoreboard. Seating for up to 500 swimmers on deck and spectator balcony seating for up to 375. The balcony seating is LIMITED to 375 and this is a "controlled seating". By order of fire marshal and CV school district, we can NOT allow more than 375 spectators in the spectator gallery at any time. Free parking next to the building. <u>Pool Certification</u> – The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) of the USA Swimming Rules & Regulations, Section 202.3.5 A or B (page 57 in the 2013 Rules & Regs). ELIGIBILITY:	This meet is open to any swimmer registered in 2014 with USA Swimming. This meet will be run according to current USA Swimming rules and regulations. Swimmer's age on the first day of the meet determines age group for the entire competition.	
ENTRY LIMITS:	Meet Director may add sessions, shift an event, limit the number of entries, eliminate certain events and/or heats, and any other reasonable modification to the meet format in order to complete sessions within the four (4) hour session limit. Notice will be provided promptly to swimmers and teams concerning modifications to the meet or changes to any entries/events/heats. Entry fees will be refunded to teams/swimmers whose entries have been rejected or who are unable to compete due to limitations. <i>Swimmers are permitted to enter four (4) events per day</i> .	
WARM-UP:	USA Swimming and Middle Atlantic safety procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures:	
	The warm-ups sessions may be divided into periods of equal length depending on the number of swimmers entered into each session. Warm-up schedules will be posted on the web site prior to the meet and will be made available to coaches at the meet.	
	Sprint/Start lanes will be available at the end of each warm-up session.	
	No diving or backstroke starts will be permitted except in sprint lanes, when designated.	
	The referee may remove anyone from the warm-up for failure to comply with warm-up rules.	
	Swimmers without a coach must report to the Meet Director before entering the pool for warm-up in order to obtain a lane assignment. Swimmers without a coach who are 12&Under will swim with and be supervised by the host club during warm-up.	
	Note: Swimmers violating safety procedures will be removed from the warm-up for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be disqualified from the remainder of the meet. Any swimmer observed swimming under or through the Bulkhead by an Official or Safety Monitor at the Meet will be disqualified from that swimmer's next Individual Event or from the remainder of the Meet, as determined by the Meet Referee. This policy will be strictly enforced.	
SWIMWEAR:	Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition.

AWARDS:	Awards are presented for 12 and under swimmers for each event based on the entry time, not on the time swum during the meet. For example, a swimmer entered into an event with an "A" time or above is eligible to receive an "A" award. A swimmer entered into the meet with a "BB" time is eligible to receive a "BB" award. Swimmers entered into the meet with a time below a "BB" or as "no time" will be eligible to receive a "C" award.

MANUALLY SUBMITTED ENTRIES	As per Middle Atlantic rules, a \$15 per swimmer fee will be charged to all entries submitted on paper rather than electronically. An additional \$25 per swimmer fee will be charged to any team submitted entries for more than 5 swimmers manually. We have information on the final page of this meet entry about a HY-Tek product that is FREE (TM-Lite). This product will assist you in completing your electronic entry.
SWIMMERS WITHOUT A COACH	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
DECK REGISTRATION	Unregistered swimmers may register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Director. The cost of registering on deck is <i>double the normal</i> fee (\$120 per swimmer for 2013-2014 registration). This applies to all swimmers attached to a club.
SWIMMERS WITH A DISIBILITY	Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted
DECK CHANGING	Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
RECORDING BAN	The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
